Letter from Llandysul Angling Association Committee

Thank you for enquiring about membership of Llandysul Angling Association. We do have a limited number of vacancies at present, and we are pleased to extend a welcome to you. But first, of course, you will want to know something about the club, the fishing opportunities it can offer you, and how we can help you if you do decide to accept this invitation. In this newsletter, you will find answers to many of the questions that new members and visitors frequently ask.

Protecting and safeguarding our river, its ecology and fish stocks have always been highest on our priorities. Consequently, our membership numbers are strictly limited and, once we reach our full allocation, late applicants go on to a waiting list. But if you apply right now there is definitely a place available for you. We have some 30 miles of salmon, trout and sea trout fishing on the most productive all-round river in Wales. This means that on most of our beats you can fish any day you like - in practice there is often no one else on the fishery at all. On three of the more popular beats we limit members to mornings or afternoons on alternate days; that way the fishery is not put under excessive pressure.

We do a lot to protect and help improve our river. We also organise free coaching for juniors (and, as we are keen to promote responsible fishing, all schoolchildren are welcome whether they are club members or not). We also run environmental education programmes for children; and, as well as providing information and guidance to members and visitors, our web site has hundreds of pages of pictures and information on wildlife and conservation matters.

Welcome Days

Each year we run a Welcome Day (beginning at 11-30 on **Saturday 28th May 2011 – date to be confirmed – please phone 01559 362202**) where new members, visitors and anyone else who wishes to can join us, free of charge, in Llandysul for:

- An illustrated introductory talk on the wildlife and fisheries of the Teifi Valley
- Refreshments (with our compliments)
- Presentation/discussion of tactics, tackle & techniques for Teifi salmon, trout and sewin
- Lunch, if you wish, with committee and local members
- Free casting tuition
- Guided visits to several of our fishing beats

Permits are available for fishing that evening and the following morning if you wish

Our fisheries in the beautiful Teifi Valley



We have 30 miles of fishing on the River Teifi, of which we own more than 20 miles. This means we are able to offer outstanding value to local and visiting anglers without suffering overcrowded fishing conditions. Indeed, most days there are no more than two dozen anglers out fishing our waters, and that leaves each person with over a mile of fishing to themselves. And even in the busiest holiday periods, you can always get away from it all if you are prepared to walk well away from our car parks and river access points.

Rod licences

Everyone over 12 years of age needs a rod licence before they may fish in freshwater in England and Wales. The 2011 full-season licence duty is approx. £71 for salmon, trout and sea trout fishing (including eels and coarse fish). For trout fishing (including coarse fish and eels) the annual licence duty is approx £27 for adults and approx £5 for juniors between the ages of 12 and 16. Short-term licences are also available for one day or for eight days.
